
His Healing Hands has come to the end of our 5-year commitment to partner with the Ethiopian Kale Hiwot Church, (EKHC), in their work to plant and grow a new evangelical church in the small town of Sendafa, Ethiopia. In every possible way our partnership in ministry with EKHC has been a testimony to what God can do when His people join together to share the Gospel message through compassionate medical care, Christian leadership training, and personal evangelism.



Dawit Teressa, the General Secretary of the Central Zone of the EKHC, sent us a wonderful letter describing the impact of the ministry in Sendafa.



Mayon Volcano Relief at Work

During 2016 and 2017, His Healing Hands sent medical mission teams to the small town of Tabaco City on the southern end of the Philippine island of Luzon. We are partnering with Pastor Daniel Cabria and Bible Baptist Church Tabaco City as they planted new churches in areas located very near to the Mayon volcano.

The Mayon volcano is the most active in the Philippines, having erupted 47 times in the past 500 years. The last major eruption was in late 2009 and lasted into early 2010.

On January 13, 2018 the volcano began to explosively erupt. The local government was very quick to respond and evacuated about 40,000 people from the danger zones.

One of the villages evacuated is called Nagsipit. This is one of the villages where Pastor Daniel and his church have planted a new congregation. The His Healing Hands medical mission teams provide medical clinics to Nagsipit in 2016 and 2017.

As soon as we learned about the eruption, we reached out to Pastor Daniel to see if he and his family and his church were in danger. He quickly responded that they were far enough away in Tabaco City to not be evacuated, but many of the evacuees had been moved into an evacuation center in the town's high school. He told us the government was struggling to provide food, clothing, medicine and other necessities for the displaced people.

We immediately wired money to Pastor Daniel so he could buy food for them and then sent out the urgent request to many of the friends of His Healing Hands for more help. You have responded in a magnificent outpouring of love for the people displaced by the Mayon eruption.

Pastor Daniel has been busy providing hot food, drinking water and clothing for over 900 people in the local evacuation center. While doing the ministry of providing food for them, Pastor Daniel saw that most of the people in the evacuation center were sleeping on the cold, hard tile floor of







the school building. The next thing he and his church did was to purchase and deliver foam sleeping mats to many of them.

During the ministry to the evacuation center, Pastor Daniel himself became very sick due to breathing the ash filled air and was hospitalized for a short time with pneumonia. But he is back on his feet again and leading his church in providing for those affected by the volcano.

It was not until March 3rd of this year that the eruptions subsided enough for the government to allow some of the people to return to their villages. These included the members of the new church plant in Nagsipit. Upon returning they found that many of their homes were damaged and all their crops were destroyed.

Now Pastor Daniel is working with the people of Nagsipit to train them how to plant and grow crops that require a shorter growing season so that they can still realize some income during the shortened growing season. Your donations will provide them with the agricultural inputs such as seeds and fertilizer that they need to get their small farms back into production. He will also continue to provide food, water and clothing to those that remain in the evacuation center.

Thank you so much for responding to the needs of the people impacted by the Mayon volcano eruption. Having Pastor Daniel as our ministry partner gives us great assurance that your donations are going directly to help those in need. It is also giving credibility to the church as he is sharing the love of Jesus with each one that is being helped by your gifts!
